

## "Key to Hope" Key Holder

### Materials Needed:

- 1 – 1" X 6" X 12" pine board
- 5 – cup hooks (\$2.00 for pack of 8)
- 2 – sawtooth hangers (\$1.50 for pack of 6)
- 12" ruler
- Fine grade sandpaper
- Paint or Stain and brush
- Hammer
- 3/32" drill bit
- Drill
- Safety glasses
- Decorative crafts

**Grade Level:** 4<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>

**Project Time:** 1 - 2 hours

### Instructions:

1. Cut 1" X 6" board to 12" lengths.
2. Sand, clean, and paint or stain board. Allow for proper dry time.
3. Place 12" ruler flush with bottom of board and mark each hook locations every 2 inches.
4. Drill marked locations pilot hole with 3/32" drill bit.
5. Flip board over and mark location 1" over and ½" down from the top corners.
6. Center sawtooth hangers over marked locations and tap in place with hammer.
7. Decorate board.
8. Screw cup hooks in to predrilled holes.  
Optional – make keys chains for new homeowners while the painted or stained boards dry. (Rainbow Looms)
